

DIPLOMA SUPPLEMENT

✚ What is it?

The Diploma Supplement is a personal document attached to a higher education diploma, issued by the higher education institutions (Universities and Higher Technological Educational Institutions) in order to make it easier for the third parties -especially for citizens of another country- to understand what the original diploma or degree represents, regarding the knowledge and the competencies of its holder.

The purpose of the supplement is to provide sufficient independent data to improve the international 'transparency' and fair academic and professional recognition of qualifications (diplomas, degrees, certificates, etc.). It is designed to provide a description of the nature, level, context, content and status of the studies that were pursued and successfully completed by the individual named on the original qualification to which this supplement is appended.

This supplement is free from any value judgments, equivalence statements or suggestions about recognition.

✚ What it isn't:

- ✓ It does not replace the original diploma/degree
- ✓ It does not give any entitlement to formal recognition of the original diploma by academic authorities of other countries

✚ Who is responsible for issuing the Diploma Supplement?

The Diploma Supplement is issued automatically by the higher educational institute that has awarded the original diploma or degree, free of charge, in both Greek and English.
